Installation Instructions for FM20






Attach the fire extinguisher bracket to the mount with the supplied small screws, washers and nuts. Decide whether you want to mount the extinguisher with the nozzle toward the center or the outside of the vehicle. Most extinguishers will fit either way but you may want to test fit before putting it all together.

Note: A thread lock compound such as Loctite is a fantastic idea here.



Remove the plastic covers over the seat mounts. They easily pop off with a flat heat screwdriver.



Remove the bolts holding the seat mounts.



Insert the supplied bolts into a washer, then into the FM20. Now slide one of the short spacers and one of the longer spacers onto the bolt as shown. Do this on both ends of the FM20.



Secure the new bolts back into the seat mount holes and tighten. Note: You might have to lift the seat a little to line the holes back up.



Connect the fire extinguisher.



All extinguishers are sized slightly different. I find that adding a Velcro cinch strap helps keep things tight if the extinguisher is a little skinny for the clamp. It is also very helpful in keeping the extinguisher secure if the clamp gets kicked open.



Most extinguishers will allow the seats to be folded all the way up. The seat may hit the nozzle or the body but only so slightly that it will not be a problem.
